

 No eating or drinking is allowed in the Computer Lab at any time.




Voices should be kept to a whisper voice.

Computers are used in many places like hotels, offices, schools, hospitals, banks and many other places.














Getting Started


1: Turn the computer on.




2: Creating Folders:

- 3- Options will appear, select **New**, then **Folder**.




4- Now you can type the name of the Folder.




